

Day 1: Tuesday, September 17, 2024 Overnight Flight You're on your way to the country of four languages that is one of the most heralded destinations in Europe. Get ready to experience the culture, history and lifestyle of Switzerland firsthand.

Day 2: Wednesday, September 18, 2024 Arrive Zurich, Switzerland - Tour Begins Welcome to Switzerland! After you land in Zurich, join a walking tour of the city. Take in the magnificent Grossmünster and Zwingli Statue, see the house where Conrad Grebel lived, and explore historic Old Town. At the end of your tour, stop for lunch in Old Town. After lunch, return to your hotel for an evening at leisure. (*L*)

Day 3: Thursday, September 19, 2024 Zurich - Glattfelden - Zurich This morning, board the local train* to Glattfelden. Spend the afternoon exploring the municipality on your own. After taking the local train back to Zurich, you will have the rest of the afternoon and evening free. Perhaps you will explore activities on Lake Zurich, or visit one of the city's famed museums. (*B*)

Day 4: Friday, September 20, 2024 Zurich - Basel - Cruise Begins Depart Zurich this morning for Basel. Upon arrival, enjoy a panoramic tour** of the city that seamlessly blends 15th century with contemporary architecture unlike anywhere else. This afternoon, board your Magical Rhine and Moselle Rivers cruise. Your home for the next seven nights, this ship offers an array of amenities including outside staterooms, unlimited wine with every dinner, and daily onboard musical performances. This evening, meet in the lounge for a cocktail reception followed by a welcome dinner. (*B*, *D*)

Day 5: Saturday, September 21, 2024 Strasbourg, France Cross the French border and experience Strasbourg, a fairytale town that blends centuries of international influences to create its own unique culture. On a guided walking tour of the old quarter, *Petite France*, and a canal cruise, take in the iconic timber-framed houses, the Cathedral of Notre Dame, and Place de la République. Make the most of some free time to explore this perfectly preserved town before returning to your ship. (*B*, *L*, *D*)

Day 6: Sunday, September 22, 2024 Speyer, Germany - Mannheim Sail to Speyer, one of Germany's oldest cities. This morning, it's your choice! Get to know Speyer on a walking tour where you will trace the story of Speyer's Jewish community from the year 1084 to today, visiting significant UNESCO sites and the modern Beith Shalom synagogue -ORfollow guides in historical garb on a journey back in time to discover the everyday lives of citizens in the Middle Ages. Later, the river takes you to Mannheim where you will have free time to explore this German city and its parks on your own. Perhaps you will join an optional excursion to Heidelberg, an ancient city of Renaissance buildings and castle ramparts. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Monday, September 23, 2024 Rhine River - Lorelei Passage - Alken - Cochem Start your morning with scenic sailing along the Rhine and through the Lorelei Passage, the river's narrowest point named for a storied siren. After lunch, dock in Alken and take a journey to Cochem, a storybook town overlooking the water. Embark on a guided tour through the

Day 8: Tuesday, September 24, 2024 Moselle River - Zell - Bernkastel Experience the Moselle Valley, starting in the over 2,000-year-old town of Zell. Board a coach and enjoy views of the beautiful wine-lined landscapes on your way to Bernkastel in the heart of the Moselle wine region. Visit a wine cellar where a local winemaker will introduce you to their culture while you enjoy a tasting of Mosel wines. Then, return to your ship in Zell to set sail this afternoon. (*B, L, D*)

Day 9: Wednesday, September 25, 2024 Cologne Your journey brings you to Cologne, where you will join a guide for a walking tour of the city's Gothic Old Town. Wander along cobblestone streets and admire the Cologne Cathedral, the Roman Dionysus mosaic, and the Romanesque church of St. Martin. Top off this walking tour with a tasting of Cologne's famous Kölsch beer. Continue your afternoon gliding along the Rhine River and passing through the picturesque German

landscapes dotted with medieval towns. End your day at the Captain's Gala Dinner – a lively celebration of food, music and entertainment. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Thursday, September 26, 2024 Amsterdam, Netherlands Begin your day in Amsterdam, a city of narrow canals and stone bridges. Cabins are available on lower (Haydn), middle (Strauss) and upper (Mozart) decks. Please note that river cruises are smaller ships and only have a finite number of each cabin category available. Specific categories are available on a first come, first served basis. Every effort will be made to accommodate your cabin choice at time of reservation; however, if that cabin category is no longer available, the closest available category will be offered. Please inquire through our Client Care Center for any upgrade fees which will apply for different cabin categories. Suites are available (Amadeus Suites) on a very limited basis.

To complete your tour, we <u>include</u> roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your <u>own air</u>, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

This itinerary is subject to change due to unforeseen changes in water levels, delays at the locks and other circumstances that may arise along the waterways. These changes may include items being missed during the tour; however, every effort will be made to substitute another attraction if possible.

Smart casual wear is recommended throughout the trip. For the welcome and farewell dinners, a dinner dress for ladies and jacket and tie for gentlemen is recommended. Comfortable walking shoes are recommended throughout the trip.

Gratuities for cabin stewards, bus boys and waiters on board the ship are not included.

Coffee or tea is included at all meals. Wine, beer and soda are included with each dinner onboard the ship.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 2. This means you like a balanced approach to travel. Walking two to three miles over the course of a day is no problem for you. You can partake in a two-hour leisurely walking tour, covering up to two miles (with included breaks). You can handle a variety of terrains, from cobblestone streets to moderate hills with relative ease and without assistance. You can climb two flights of stairs with ease. There may be 1 to 2 days on this tour when walking tours can cover 3 to 4 miles over uneven terrain. Expect some full days balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. You can handle altitudes up to 6,000 feet. While this level is appropriate for travelers that require mobility assistance devices, there could be times when you may have to sit out on some of the included activities. In Cochem, the included walking tour is approximately 3 hours in duration.



There is adequate walking required to cross the bridge into town, and expect to navigate through cobblestone streets on your way to Reichsburg Castle. In order to access the castle, there's a ramp to walk up; there is no elevator available.

Please be advised many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

The cruise line reserves the right to charge a supplemental fuel charge. Should this charge be incurred, you will be notified in advance.
