Fellow members of the Glattfelder family:

The 107th annual family reunion will be held at Heimwald Park, Glatfelters, PA (near Seven Valleys) on Saturday July 28 and Sunday July 29. There will be temporary signs on the reunion weekend to help guide you. The address of the park is 6581 Glatfelters Station Rd., Seven Valleys PA 17360.

Again this year, PennDOT has several bridges closed for replacement which may affect your travel. The PA 214 (Main Street) bridge in Seven Valleys is closed, as is the bridge on Reynolds Mill Road between Water Street and Twin Arch Road. Glatfelter Station Road is the only bridge over the Codorus Creek between those two closures, so the road past the park will be carrying a higher volume of traffic than we are accustomed to. Please be extra cautious both in driving and in walking along this road!

Please note: According to the Charter of Incorporation granted in 1910 by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Heimwald Park is to be alcohol-free. Kindly respect our governing document by not bringing alcohol into the park.

As always, parking will be available in the parking lot of the York County Heritage Rail Trail and the meadow beyond. Shuttle vans operated by the Seven Valleys Fire Police will be available to transport you to the park.

The theme of this year's reunion is "Glattfelders in the War of 1812."

On Saturday July 28, the park will be open for your picnicking pleasure beginning at 3:00 PM. While board and lawn games will be available, no formal program is planned until the arrival of the Brodbecks Band at 4:00 PM. At 5:00, some of York County's finest foods will be served: Sechrist hot dogs (with optional sauerkraut); fresh Brenneman chow-chow; soft pretzels; and Carmen's ice cream. Donation jars will remind you to help support this event. Dr. Charles Glatfelter **will not** be present on Saturday evening.

On Sunday July 29, registration will open at 11:30 AM. The catered meal will begin at 12:30 PM. **We ask you to be in the park and seated before 12:30.** We will be using the same caterer as last year, serving broasted chicken or a vegetarian lunch. Everyone who is able is encouraged to bring something to be placed on the family dessert table.

The charge for the meal remains \$12.00 for adults and \$8.00 for children 6 - 12; the same as last year. If you plan to attend, please use the enclosed form and addressed envelope to make reservations. Please mail your reservation no later than July 14 so that we have time to give the caterers an accurate count.

Many of the items you have seen on the order form in the newsletter, including polo shirts, stationery, 100th Reunion books, and a DVD of a recent visit to Glattfelden, will be available for sale.
